Doorstep is a partnership of over 50 congregations in Topeka that includes Christian, Jewish, and Islamic communities working together to address the needs of our city. A couple of those congregations are selected each month to be the lead volunteers for the ministries that they do. Please look at the insert in your worship bulletin for information about how you can get involved in the Clothing Room or the Food Pantry. A meeting with Executive Director Lisa Cain showed me how much of a difference that the good work that is being done at Trinity influences the lives of those in need in Topeka. Hopefully, this month, you can also visit or volunteer at Doorstep to see for yourself the great work that can be done

when we work together.


We will also be heading to Synod Assembly this month in Overland Park. Myself and Mary Heald will be the congregational representatives. While there are no major legislative issues that are known at this time, there will be a Bishop's election that will dominate the meeting. Bishops in the ELCA serve a term of six years in office. Bishop Gustafson has decided to retire instead of stand for another term. Therefore, the office will be filled by an election at the Assembly. There are six candidates currently running and their profiles can be accessed at (https:// www.css-elca.org/ candidates). To give a little background, five of the six are resident here in the Synod; the other is from Louisiana. Three of them you know rather well either as supply or synod staff. Two are currently pastors in churches and another represents Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago. No matter what the result might be, we wish the



best for these candidates as they have followed God's whisper in their ears and pray for the Holy Spirit to guide our election for the person that we need as a synod to live into lives based on the Gospel. The Assembly will be held from June 6th-8th and I ask that you pray for the Synod and the Church during this time...

"Almighty God, you have given your Holy Spirit to the church to lead us into all truth. Bless with the Spirit's grace and presence the people of the Central States Synod as we prepare to elect a bishop. Keep us steadfast in faith and united in love, that we may manifest your glory and prepare for the way of your kingdom; through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord. Amen."
