Luther's German Mass

Martin Luther was asked by early Lutherans to produce a worship service that could unite all the churches that had separated from the Catholic Church. At the time, each church reformed the Mass according to their own ideas, which created a multiplication of ways to worship. On October 29, 1525, the German Mass was held in Wittenberg as composed by Luther. This was the first worship service to use the vernacular instead of Latin. It was approved by council on Christmas Day 1525 for all Lutherans to share in a common worship pattern and was printed for churches to use the following year.

C hear our prayer.


P God our hope and strength, we entrust to you all for whom we pray. Remain with us always, through Jesus Christ, our Savior.





THE CREED


P Let us confess our faith with the words of the Apostle's Creed.
