



FIRST READING: ACTS 10:34-43

<sup>34</sup>Peter began to speak to the people: "I truly understand that God shows no partiality, <sup>35</sup>but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him. <sup>36</sup>You know the message he sent to the people of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ—he is Lord of all. <sup>37</sup>That message spread throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John announced: <sup>38</sup>how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. <sup>39</sup>We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. #### SECOND READING: 1ST CORINTHIANS 15:19-26


<sup>19</sup>If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied. <sup>20</sup>But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died. <sup>21</sup>For since death came through a human being, the resurrection of the dead has also come through a human being; <sup>22</sup>for as all die in Adam, so all will be made alive in Christ. <sup>23</sup>But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. <sup>24</sup>Then comes the end, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father, after he has destroyed every ruler and every authority and power. <sup>25</sup>For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. <sup>26</sup>The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

<sup>1</sup>At daybreak on the first day of the week the women who had come from Galilee with Jesus took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. <sup>2</sup>They found the stone rolled away from the tomb; <sup>3</sup>but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. <sup>4</sup>While they were puzzling over this, behold, two men in dazzling garments appeared to them. <sup>5</sup>They were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground. They said to them, "Why do you seek the living one among the dead?

<sup>6</sup>He is not here, but he has been raised. Remember what he said to you while he was still in Galilee, <sup>7</sup>that the Son of Man must be handed over to sinners and be crucified, and rise on the third day." <sup>8</sup>And they remembered his words. <sup>9</sup>Then they returned from the tomb and announced all these things to the eleven and to all the others. <sup>10</sup>The women were Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James; the others who accompanied them also told this to the apostles, <sup>11</sup>but their story seemed like nonsense and they did not believe them. <sup>12</sup>But Peter got up and ran to the tomb, bent down, and saw the burial cloths alone; then he went home amazed at what had happened.
