## Upcoming Events

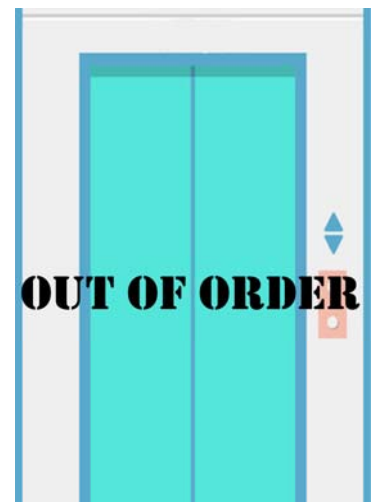
