Treasurer report as of 3-31-2026

Income and Expense update

Year to date giving totals \$26,527.72 with March's giving totaling \$8049. The giving year to date annualizes to a giving amount of \$106,112 which is below budget estimates of \$119,000.

Year to date expenses totaled \$25,965.06, which results in a favorable cash flow of our operating expenses and \$562.66 in YTD income over expenses.

Restricted giving totaled \$646.00 for the month, with \$310 for camp Tomah Shinga and \$336 for easter flowers.

Our financial performance to date is allowing us to cover our expenses, but giving needs to increase to help cover future expenses not yet recognized, primarily our property insurance that is payable each quarter. We are averaging \$8,842 a month and budgeted for \$9,918 a month.
